2009 Rules of eligibility for Year End Class Points

1. Driver of Record may “drop” one points race out of the five total points races scheduled for 2009. The total points of the four highest scoring events for each Driver of Record will be used to determine each Class Champion.
2. Driver of Record must compete in at least three events to qualify for Year End Points Champion.
3. Driver of Record must start or finish the race. Only Driver of Record will receive points. See section DDC5.1 and DDC5.2 of the official DRIVE Off-Road Racing Rulebook for exceptions.
4. In the event of the Driver of Record being disqualified all points for that event will be forfeited.
5. If the Driver of Record is suspended from racing at any DRIVE Off-Road Racing event for any reason all points for all races will be forfeited and the Driver of Record with the second most points will be awarded the Championship for his or her class.
6. The Driver of Record and all team Co-Driver/Riders must sign a release form and obtain a wristband.
7. The competitor with the highest number of points for each class at the end of the championship series will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie for any class title, the competitor with the most first place finishes will be declared the winner. In the event that there is still a tie, the competitor with the most second place finishes will be declared the winner. If the tie cannot be broken the Driver of Record with the fastest average speed (averaged from his or her three fastest events) will be titled the Champion.

Additional points available on top of the Points Table

- (2) points for registering before the drawing date
- (2) points for fastest lap time in each class
